The transnational Cooperation Program Dunav (Danube) gathers 9 EU member states: Austria, Germany (two regions Baden – Württemberg and Bavaria), Slovakia, Czech

Republic, Slovenia, Hungary, Romania, Bulgaria and Croatia; three IPA countries: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro and Serbia, as well as two ENI partner countries: Moldova and Ukraine (4 regions: Chernivetska area, Ivano-Frankiviska area, Zakarpatska area, Odessa area). This program will invest €202,3 billion from European Regional Development Fund and €19,8 billion from the IPA II transnational projects on the Danube region territory.

The main goal of the program is promotion of economic, social and territorial cohesion in the region Dunav (Danube) through the integration of the policies in significant area of activity. In order to achieve higher level of territorial integration of this heterogeneous area, Transnational Cooperation Program Dunav (Danube) will act as as a policy driver to tackle common challenges and needs in specific policy fields, where transnational cooperation is expected to deliver tangible results.

Specific areas included by the program:

1. Innovative and socially responsible Danube region (Improving framework conditions for innovation; increasing competences for business and social innovation)

2. Environment and culture responsible Danube region (better governance of the water resources, food risk, restoration of ecological corridors)

3. Better connected and energy responsible Danube region (ecological transport systems support; energy efficiency improvement)

4. Well-governed Danube region (institutional capacities strengthening)

- International organizations
